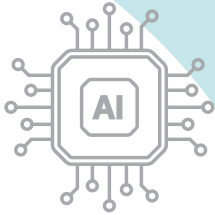

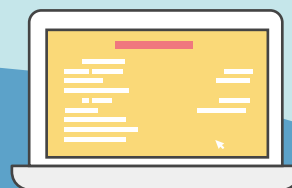
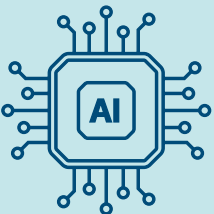

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About the Workshop

India has a long history of publishing journals and periodicals primarily in Indian languages, especially in fields such as literature, history, religious studies, drama, music, civilization, yoga, Ayurveda, spirituality and Indian Knowledge Systems. Researchers from these fields prefer to disseminate their findings in their native languages. However, many of these journals, often published by small publishing houses, struggle to maintain standard publishing practices similar to journals indexed in world standard databases. Organizing a workshop for editors and publishers of Indian language journals is a pivotal step toward enhancing the visibility and impact of these invaluable publications. By equipping editors and publishers with best practices, tools, and strategies, this workshop aims to elevate the quality and accessibility of their journals. Through robust editorial standards, effective peer review processes, and innovative dissemination techniques, we can ensure that these journals not only preserve regional heritage but also gain recognition on global platforms.

Predatory publications, publish-or-perish pressure, evolving publishing models, and AI-powered writing tools are creating significant challenges for publishers and editors of Indian language journals. Maintaining integrity and staying current with knowledge updates requires new approaches to research evaluation and dissemination. To effectively address these issues, thorough training in research ethics, responsible authorship, and robust editorial policies is essential. Raising awareness of global standard publishing practices will help publishers enhance the visibility and credibility of their journals. In view of this, the Centre for Publication Ethics (CPE) and the Ayush Center of Excellence, Center for Complementary and Integrative Health (CCIH) are jointly organizing a two-day workshop during **11-12 April, 2025** titled “**Best Publishing Practices for Editors of Indian Language Journals and Indian Knowledge Systems.**” This workshop will provide crucial insights and tools to help Indian language journals cope with the rapidly changing publishing landscape.
